


Catalonia: Population Density



Red Blood Cells concentrates 247,910



Healthcare System in Catalonia

- Public system under the control of the autonomous government of the region (Generalitat de Catalunya)
- Universal healthcare coverage. About 20% of population have also private healthcare insurance.
- Hospital network:
 - High complexity, university, hospitals are of public ownership
 - Medium and low complexity, private ownership although most of them treat also patients from the public insurance under special contracts
- Blood and tissue bank of Catalonia is also of public ownership
- Hospitals and BTBC receive the money directly from the Generalitat of Catalonia.





Blood Transfusion in Catalonia

- Since 1993 the Blood and Tissue Bank of Catalonia started taking over the hospital transfusion services of the University Hospitals.
- With BTBC staff (doctors, nurses and technicians) working at the transfusion services of the hospitals
- Currently, of the 10 university hospitals, 8 of them are run by the BTBC
- Only the Hospital del Mar and the University Clinic Hospital, both in Barcelona, have hospital transfusion services run by hospital staff




University Clinic Hospital: Transfusional Activity in units

Conclusions

- Merging of Blood Centers is supported by reasons of efficiency, standardization, quality and cost savings due to economies of scales.
- In Catalonia consolidation of blood centers was completed 9 years ago.
- Some of the hospital transfusion services were also taken over by the Blood Center.
- Although the standard transfusion needs of Hospitals are fully met, the adaptation to its emerging needs and the inclusion of new technologies might be hampered by the organizational complexity of large institutions.
